

**IOWA-GRANT SCHOOL DISTRICT
NOTIFICATION OF VOCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES
(SECTION 204(G) OF THE CARL B. PERKINS VOCATIONAL EDUCATION ACT)**

Each year, the Iowa-Grant School District offers vocational education programs at IGEMS and the High School. These programs are designed to prepare youth for a broad range of employment and training services and are offered under the guidance of certified teachers, counselors and cooperative education coordinators.

Iowa-Grant Schools offer vocational programs in agriculture education, business education, and technology education.

Specific courses in agriculture and natural resources are: Introduction to Agriculture, Natural Resource Management, Animal Science, Equipment Maintenance/Repair (TR), Introduction to Welding (TR), Advanced Welding (TR), Landscape Design/Greenhouse Management (TR), Plant Science (TR), Land and Soil Management (TR), Landscape Design, Food Science, Pre-Veterinary Science, Veterinary Science (TR), Agri-business Management (TR), and Employment in Agriculture/Coop Work Experience.

Specific courses in business: Personal Finance (TR), Accounting 1 and 2 (TR), Accounting 3, Computer Literacy and Applications I, Computer Literacy and Applications II, Work Place Communication (TR), Principles of Business, Marketing & Finance (FBLA), Business Occupations Work Experience.

Specific courses in technology and engineering include: Woodworking Construction, Pre-Engineering, Web Design (PLTW), Principles of Engineering (PLTW) (TR), Engineering Design and Development (PLTW) (TR), Product Development and Design, and Film and Media Production.

Work experience is offered in the area of the student's choice or most generally in: business, health, agriculture, hospitality/tourism, retail.

All vocational education programs follow the district's policies of nondiscrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or handicap in all activities and in employment. In addition arrangements can be made to ensure that the lack of English language skills is not a barrier to admission or participation.
