CRITERIA:

- ✓ Local Scholarship Application form must be completed by deadline.

- ✓ Typed 200 to 250 word essay answering a standard question.

ESSAY:

The following criteria is required for the essay:

- ✓ Typed (double spaced).
- ✓ 1-inch margins (size 12, New Times Roman font).
- ✓ Name and deadline date typed at the top of the essay.

ESSAY QUESTION:

During your high school experience, what do you feel you have done to make Iowa-Grant High School a better, more positive environment, and what do you feel you have gained from your years at Iowa-Grant High School to carry with you throughout the rest of your life?
